

Executive Committee Meeting August 22, 2025 Virtual Meeting 8:30 am - 9:00 am

- I. Welcome Chairman Scott Johnson
- II. Report: Georgia Literacy Coaching Kickoff Event Stacey Lutz
 - ➤ Thank you to all those who attended the Literacy Coaching Kickoff.
 - ➤ The event included the coaches from all 3 of our state and federally funded coaching programs (Let's Read, Growing Readers, and CSI Coaches).
 - > Over 250 attended the event in Warner Robins.
 - > All three systems came together collectively with integrated content.
 - ➤ The Coaching Coordinating Committee held 2 meetings and reviewed the proposal from the Deal Center.
- III. Vote: Coaching Committee Research Proposal
 - > Stacey Lutz provided an overview of the proposal for the Deal Center to provide support for a cohesive coaching model.
 - ➤ The proposal includes a landscape analysis, development of coaching competencies, and research and evaluation support. The total proposal budget is \$1,052,730.35.
 - ➤ The Committee engaged in questions and discussion around the deliverables, budget, and timeline of the proposal.
 - Chairman Hickman asked about how the deliverables will be managed per the contract. He asked that we "trust but verify" the work being completed.
 - Stacey Lutz stated that there would be a more specific contract for deliverables, outlined with clear documentation.
 - Chairman Hickman requested regular progress reports on the work.
 - Chairman Erwin asked about the timeline of deliverables and specifics on the contract outcomes.
 - Stacey Lutz explained that a scope of work with a timeline would be created.
 - Dr. Lindee Morgan explained that the contract would be created through Georgia College and GOSA.

- Dr. DeJarnett expressed the need to move forward with appropriate speed on the coordination of a multiagency initiative.
- Andri Pilgrim asked about the personnel and positions in the proposal.
 - Dr. Morgan shared that there was flexibility in the positions listed as far as personnel.
- Mrs. Dayle Burns asked about the next steps for the proposal.
 - Stacey Lutz spoke about assessment development.
- Mrs. Dayle Burns asked about how professional learning is addressed in the proposal.
 - Stacey Lutz shared that an outcome would be a codified system of professional learning aligned with the competencies. She shared that two professional learning specialists are part of the contract.
- Mrs. Dayle Burns asked about how this work would impact children and student data.
 - Stacey Lutz expressed that we will be working to map coaching support to teachers and student outcomes.
- Chairman Johnson reiterated the focus on children learning to read as our goal outcome for this work.
- Senator Hickman thanked Mrs. Dayle for asking about the focus on children and reiterated it as a priority.
- Dr. DeJarnett stated that we need to be sure that we are considering student growth when looking at data.
- > Chairman Johnson called for a vote.
 - Dr. Stan DeJarnett motioned to approve the proposal.
 Chairman Billy Hickman gave a second.
 - Chairman Scott Johnson, Dr. Stan DeJarnett, Chairman Billy Hickman, and Mrs. Andri Pilgrim voted yes. Chairman Chris Erwin Voted No.
